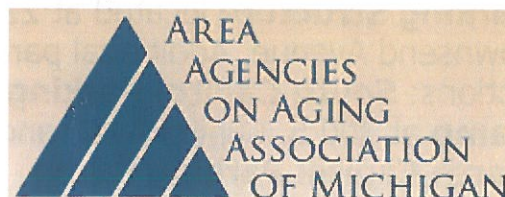

Capitol Ave.; and the **North Capitol Parking Ramp** (floors 2-5) at 316 N. Capitol Ave. If you are driving a bus, **Buses should drop off at the front of the building on Capitol Avenue** and then park at the State Historical Museum
