

COURSE RULES & POLICIES



Rules & Etiquette

- Each player must have their own bag and clubs
- Non- Golfers (Riders) \$6 Cart Fee. Non-Playing Juniors Must be 8 Years or Older and under the strict supervision of an Adult
- Non-Playing Walkers are NOT allowed
- Golf Carts are available for rental to anyone 16 and older with a valid State driver's license
- Only 2 People per Golf Cart
- Groups booking with less than a foursome are subject to being paired with another party
- No Fivesomes allowed
- Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times (non-metal spikes). No tank tops
- All outside alcoholic beverages are strictly prohibited. All alcoholic beverages must be purchased on site in accordance with our liquor license
- Repair your ball marks, replace divots and rake the bunkers
- Keep carts 30ft from the greens and tees
- Golfers are responsible for any damages caused by errant golf shots

Junior Golf Policy

- Juniors age 13 and older may play without adult supervision
- Ages 8-12 are eligible to play under the strict supervision of an Adult (exception for Kids Play Free on Sundays after 2pm & Monday Night Parent/Kid League-see below)
- Kids Play Free on Sundays after 2pm & Monday Night Parent/Kid League ages 6 years and Older may play under the strict supervision of an Adult
- Juniors under age 8 are NOT allowed on the golf course. This includes riding in a golf cart with an Adult or walking the course with an Adult (except during Kids Play Free on Sundays after 2pm & Monday Night Parent/Kid League where kids may be 6 years and older).

Pace of Play

- 9 Holes Completed- 2 hours and 15 minutes
- Please keep pace with the group in front of you
- Consider "ready golf" instead of playing in the order of play
- Bring multiple clubs with you to your shot when uncertain
- You may be asked by a ranger to speed up play if falling behind

Violations of the rules or any breach of golf etiquette will result in removal from the course.
