Westland Partners with Wayne County to Launch Free Drive Thru COVID-19 Testing Clinic – The City of Westland has established a free drive thru COVID-19 testing clinic to assist in the Wayne County COVID Testing. Residents will have no out of pocket expenses for testing. However, if insurance information is available, it will be collected for the laboratory testing fees. There is no pre-registration or appointments needed. Minors must be accompanied by a parent or guardian. Residents can expect to receive their results within 2-3 days, which will be shared via email, phone call or text message. The testing will take place in the parking lot of Westland Friendship Center located at 1119 Newburgh Road. The testing hours will be **Monday through Friday 9:00 a.m. – 7:00 p.m. and Saturday 9:00 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.**

William P. Faust Library located at 6123 Central City Parkway will begin **Phase II** of their opening on **Monday, January 11, 2021**.
