## **Garden City Hospital, in Partnership with the City of Westland, Opens Westland Community Health Center**

The community health center is located at 35700 Warren Road in Westland. The Westland Community Health Center is equipped with a state-of-the-art free-standing emergency department which offers access to quality care, close to home. The free-standing emergency department will be operated by experienced and knowledgeable staff that has brought Garden City Hospital local and national recognition for clinical expertise and patient safety. Along with an emergency department the health center is home to outpatient family medicine clinic, physical therapy office and specialty physician offices, offering Westland access to a wide range of medical services in one convenient location.
