

The annual celebration will take place at Westland City Hall, located at 36300 Warren Rd. beginning with a short Freedom Walk at 9:00 a.m., weather permitting. The Freedom Walk will honor those who marched with Dr. King during Detroit's Walk to Freedom 59 years ago.

City Hall doors will open beginning at 8:30 a.m.. The program is set to begin at 10:00 a.m. and will include inspiring messages from Mayor William R. Wild as well as other state and local elected officials. Wayne County Sheriff Raphael "Ray" Washington will deliver the Keynote Address. Light refreshments will be provided by the Westland Police Community Partnership Committee.
