Westland Partners with Quality Care Testing for Free Drive Through COVID –19 Testing Clinic – The City of Westland has established a free drive through COVID-19 testing clinic located in the parking lot of The Westland City Hall located at 36300 Warren Road. Residents will have no out of pocket expenses for testing, if insurance is available, it will be collected at the time of testing. There is no pre-registration or appointments required. Do not take any fever reducing medication prior to testing. This is a PCR test, results will be given within 48-72 hours, via text, email or phone call. The federal government has over 500 million at home rapid tests to be distributed throughout the United States.
