**COVID-19 Vaccination Site at Jefferson Barns Community Vitality Center** – In response to recent COVID positive cases surging in Westland and the surrounding area, Wayne County Public Health Division is set to begin COVID-19 vaccinations at the Jefferson Barns Community Vitality Center, located at 32150 Dorsey Road. This Clinic will open on **February 9th and go through March 31st**. The hours of operation are Monday 12:30 p.m. – 5:00 p.m., Tuesday 10:30 a.m. –4:00 p.m.,

Wednesday 12:30 p.m. – 5:00 p.m., Thursday 10:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m. and Friday 10:30 a.m. – 4:00 p.m.

**KN95 Masks** – The City of Westland has received KN95 masks and other personal protection equipment. This is available for Westland Residents free of charge at the Greeter's desk at Westland City Hall located at 36300 Warren Road. There is a limit of 5 KN95 masks per resident. Residents can also receive hand sanitizer, individual alcohol wipes and face shields. Residents can pick up the equipment on Monday through Friday from 9:00 a.m. through 5:00 p.m.

**Mayor Wild urges Westland residents to take advantage of the federal government's free COVID-19 testing program.** The federal government has over 500 million at home rapid tests to be distributed throughout the United States. Each household is eligible for four free tests that will be shipped directly to the resident's home. **Westland Partners with Quality Care Testing for Free Drive Through COVID –19 Testing Clinic** – The City of Westland has established a free drive through COVID-19 testing clinic located in the parking lot of The Westland City Hall located at 36300 Warren Road. Residents will have no out of pocket expenses for testing, if insurance is available, it will be collected at the time of testing. There is no pre-registration or appointments required. Do not take any fever reducing medication prior to testing. This is a PCR test, results will be given within 48-72 hours, via text, email or phone call.
