Mayor Wild and City Council Announce Board and Commissions Appointments & Reappointments

Westland, MI (March 8, 2022) The City of Westland has announced several reappointments and new appointments to three City Boards, including the Zoning Board of Appeals, the Board of Review, and the Building Board of Appeals.




Eileen DeHart-Schoof has been reappointed to the Zoning Board of Appeals for a three-year term to expire May 2025. An active resident in the All-American City, DeHart-Schoof is a former City Clerk, Councilwoman and State Representative. DeHart-Schoof was nominated and reappointed by Westland City Council.

John Sullivan Esq. was appointed by Mayor William R. Wild to the Board of Review as an alternate to fill an unexpired term, made immediately effective by City Council and will expire September 2023. Mr. Sullivan is a local attorney and also served as Wayne County Commissioner from 1999 until 2007. He has also served on the Youth Assistance Advisory Board since March

2021 and the Local Development Finance Authority, or LDFA, since April 2021.



Mel Tockstein (left) and Michael Koelzer (right) have both been reappointed to the Building Board of Appeals, each serving a three-year term to expire March 2025. Mr. Tockstein has been a longtime resident of the City of Westland and has served on the Commission on Aging since 2005 and the Board of Review since 2010. Mr. Koelzer is an instructor at the William D. Ford Career Technical Center teaching construction technology.
