Westland City Council Approves 1.5 Million Neighborhood Road and Watermain Reconstruction Project



Westland, Michigan (May 19, 2022) - The Westland City Council unanimously approved the bid for the Westchester Drive Road and Water Reconstruction Project.

The project will include the replacement of the existing 6 inch water main with new 8 inch water main and new concrete pavement through water mains along Barrington, Berkshire, Middlebury, and Parkwood. Work for the project is estimated to begin by mid-June and be completed by mid-August. The construction schedule is tentative and may be subject to change weather pending.

The project was approved by City Council for the 2021-2022 fiscal year through the water and sewer fund. The project will not exceed \$1,542384.20.

"This project will help improve the water mains and include new integral curb, driveways, striping/signage, sidewalk ramps, storm structures, says Ramzi El-Gharib, Director of the Department of Public Service
