Two Westland Intersections To See New Developments

Westland, MI (June 21, 2022) – The Westland City Council unanimously approved two Site Plans for a business that will help your car last longer and one that will help your pet live longer. Heartland Veterinary Clinic, located at Ford Road and Carlson and an Oil Change Shop, located at Warren Road and Venoy had the Site Plans approved at the June 20, 2022 Westland City Council Meeting.

Heartland Veterinary Clinic, which will be located at 36391 Ford Road that involves the demolition of the existing veterinary clinic on the adjacent parcel and the construction of a 4,865 square foot full service veterinary clinic with a beautiful modern design in the heart of Westland's Downtown Development Authority (DDA) area. The DDA had previously purchased this site, which housed an automotive use, for redevelopment in 2015.

“The DDA was very excited to help this project come to fruition,” commented Aubrey Berman, Economic Development Director. “Not only is this a catalyst for future development on the former City Hall site, but it helps to retain an existing business, provide them opportunity for growth and brings non-conforming parcels in-line with our future plans for the corridor.”



A new Oil Change Shop, which will be located at 32911 Warren Road, will be renovating and adding new construction to the site which has been an inactive business location since 2007. The developer, Mr. Steve Hamade has transformed three of the four corners at Warren and Venoy into very successful and unique

locations.



"We are very excited to add these two business to a pair of the City's very high profile intersections in our business community. Both projects are very appealing and will enhance the look of our community," said Mayor William R. Wild.
