Mayor Michael P. Londeau Announces Five New Initiatives

Westland, MI (January 31, 2023) – Mayor Michael P. Londeau hits the ground running by announcing five new initiatives aimed at enhancing the quality of life for residents and visitors of Westland. These initiatives, carefully crafted with input from city staff, community members and local leaders, reflect a commitment to sustainable growth, quality of life improvements and a brighter future for all.

Initiative 1: Leaf Pick-Up Program

The city will re-implement a leaf pick-up program by the Fall of 2023

Initiative 2: Bulk Pick-Up

The city will upgrade and streamline its bulk trash pick-up process in order to make it more customer friendly and simpler to navigate

Initiative 3: Neighborhood Makeover Program 2.0

Having just completed the originally planned 5 year cycle of the NMP, we will be implementing the next phase which will dig deeper into neighborhood improvement needs with an augmented plan which emphasizes identifying any and all deficient or hazardous sidewalks in Westland's neighborhoods. Once this is completed, we will then begin with the process of replacing / repairing any problem areas *at no cost to homeowners*.

Initiative 4: The Westland Shopping Center

The city will establish a task force within the administration to explore the possibility of purchasing the Westland Shopping Center

Initiative 5: Ford Road Corridor

The city will explore any and all opportunities for a Recreational Complex to be constructed on the City-owned property along Ford Road.

“These initiatives are a crucial step in creating a better future for our residents. We are dedicated to making Westland a more vibrant, sustainable, and inclusive community for all,” Mayor Londeau stated. In addition to these initiatives, Mayor Londeau also announced that the

Mayor's Office would be hitting the road with a series of Community Summits at various locations around the City.
