## City of Westland Awarded \$4.75 Million in State Budget Funding for Fire Department and Wayne Road Streetscaping

Mayor Kevin Coleman is thrilled to announce that the City of Westland has been awarded \$4.75 million in State of Michigan Budget Appropriations for fiscal year 2024–2025.

The breakdown of the allocation is as follows: \$3.5 million for upgrades to Fire Station #4 on Palmer Rd., \$1 million for Wayne Road streetscaping and beautification, and \$250,000 for 2024 special election reimbursement funding.



"I would like to thank Senator Dayna Polehanki and State Representative Peter Herzberg for their hard work in advocating for the City of Westland in Lansing," stated Mayor Coleman. "This much needed funding will be used to invest in public safety and local infrastructure for our City."
