- Westland City Hall (36300 Warren Road) Monday through Friday 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.
- William P. Faust Public Library (6123 Central City Parkway) Monday through Thursday 9 a.m. – 9 p.m., Friday and Saturday 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.
 - Closed Wednesday, June 19 in observance of Juneteenth
- Westland Friendship Senior Center (1119 Newburgh Road) Monday through Friday 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.
- Jefferson Barns Community Vitality Center (32150 Dorsey) Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday 9 a.m. – 7 p.m., Thursday and Friday 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.
- Westland Fire Station #1 (35701 Central City Parkway) 8 a.m. – 8 p.m.
- Westland Police Station Lobby (36701 Ford Rd) 24 hours, 7 days a week.

Mayor Coleman encourages residents to stay safe and take precautions in these extreme temperatures. This includes drinking fluids, wearing lightweight clothing, and knowing the signs of heat exhaustion/stroke. Make sure to check on family, neighbors and pets as the extreme heat heightens throughout the coming week.
