Join us to honor and remember the brave men and women who have sacrificed their lives for our freedom for the **Wayne–Westland Memorial Day Parade and Remembrance Ceremony on Sunday, May 26**. The parade will commence at 1 p.m., starting from John Glenn High School (36105 Marquette) and heading north towards the Veterans Memorial Garden of Westland, (6123 Central City Pkwy). The parade will be followed by a ceremony to pay respect to the fallen heroes who gave everything for our nation.

City offices will be closed on Monday, May 27 in observance of Memorial Day. This includes the Westland Public Library, 18th District Court, City Hall, and the Recycling Center. They will be open on Tuesday, May 28 for regular hours. Trash pick-up will also be delayed by one day due to the holiday.
