Effective September 30, 2024, residents no longer need to schedule special pickups for large or bulk items. Bulk items are to be placed on the curbside but separated from trash/recycling containers. Bulk pickups will be the same day as your bi-weekly recycling pickup. **The bulk pick-up program has replaced the leaf program.** This decision was made after receiving feedback from the community and community stakeholders. **As a result, there will be complimentary compost bags available at Westland City Hall through December 13.** There is a limit of 10 bags per household. Westland City Hall is located at 36300 Warren Road and is open Monday–Friday 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.

For those who wish to vote early and in-person for the General Election, early voting will be available at the City Clerk's Office from Saturday, October 26, through Sunday, November 3. Please be advised that all City of Westland offices will be closed on Tuesday, November 5., in observance of the General Election. Regular operations will resume on Wednesday, November 6.
