Mayor Kevin Coleman Invites You to the Ted Scott Fire Station 2 Dedication & Ribbon Cutting Ceremony

Why: Celebrate the Grand Opening of New State-Of-The-Art Fire Station

Westland, MI – Join Mayor Kevin Coleman, members of the Westland Fire Department, dignitaries, residents, the business community and the press for the Ribbon Cutting Ceremony of the new 13,000 square foot Ted Scott Fire Station 2.

The City of Westland has 91 uniformed fire personnel, the most in the City's history, and responds to more than 16,000 runs annually.

This state-of-the-art facility will house our Fire Administration, our personnel for Engine 2 and Rescue 2, the Brian Woehlke Command Training Center and the 3 story Todd Stanaway Training Tower.

Ted Scott began his career with the Nankin Township Fire Department in 1959. He served the community, which became the City of Westland in 1966,

for 26 years, serving his last five years as Fire Chief.

Todd Stanaway began his career with the department in 1995 and served the community for 13 years, until his unfortunate passing from occupational cancer in 2008.

Brian Woehlke served the community for 10 months during 2012 & 2013, before his line-of-duty-death battling a commercial structure fire.

This \$9.5 million project was funded by a \$7 million grant from the State of Michigan and \$2.5 million in ARPA funds from the Westland City Council. This station will replace the current Fire Station 2, which is the City's oldest fire station.

On this solemn day of remembrance, we also dedicate a new symbol of resilience and service. The Ted Scott Fire Station 2 is a reminder of the courage of those we lost, the service of those who stand watch today and the responsibility we all share to protect the future.
