In response to the extreme heat, Mayor Kevin Coleman will open several cooling centers.

- Westland City Hall, 36300 Warren Road; Monday through Friday 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.
- William P. Faust Public Library, 6123 Central City Parkway, Monday through Thursday from 9 a.m. – 9 p.m., Friday through Saturday 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.
- Westland Friendship Senior Center, 1119 Newburgh Road, Monday and Friday 9 a.m. – 5 p.m., Tuesdays, Wednesdays and Thursdays from 9 a.m. – 7 p.m.
- Jefferson Barns Community Vitality Center, 32150 Dorsey, Monday through Wednesday, 9 a.m. – 7 p.m., Thursday and Friday, 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.
- Westland Fire Department:
 - Fire Station #1, 35701 Central City Parkway, 8 a.m. – 8 p.m., 7 days a week.
 - Westland Police Department Lobby, 36701 Ford Rd, 24 hours, 7 days a week.

We encourage everyone to use caution when we experience high temperatures. Below are some tips to stay safe:

- Drink plenty of fluids to stay hydrated
- Stay out of direct sunlight if possible
- Wear loose, lightweight, light-colored clothing
- Don't leave people or pets in your car and check on others
- Avoid high energy activity or outdoor work during midday heat, if possible
- Check on family, seniors and neighbors
- Know the signs of heat sickness and watch for heat cramps, heat exhaustion and heat stroke
