Westland Housing Commission – Veterans Supportive Housing Project-Based Program

The Westland Housing Commission will provide up to 15 housing vouchers in support of the Veterans Supportive Housing Project-Based Program.

This program will include the following components:

- Rental of approved 1, 2, or 3 bedroom units under the Program, located in the Norwayne subdivision.
- Partnership with approved housing providers ("sponsoring agency") and other supportive service agencies such as Wayne Metropolitan Community Action Agency to identify eligible applicants and provide counseling and supportive services for permanent housing.
- Rental assistance is in the form of a project-based housing voucher.

Application/Participation criteria:

- Income at or below 50 percent of area median income, verified in accordance with HUD criteria.
- Head-of-household must be a veteran (with honorable discharge).
- All adult family members must pass criminal background check, in accordance with the Westland Housing Commission criteria.
- Family must participate in Family Self Sufficiency program, managed by the Westland Housing Commission, through Wayne Metropolitan Community Action Agency, including (but not limited to): job training, budgeting, homecare class, Contract of Participation.
- Family must contribute volunteer hours, through activities associated with the Norwayne Community Citizens Council.
- Rental owners may reject applicants based on previous rental history, etc.
- Two or more unrelated adults may share a 2-bedroom unit.

Housing Providers:

- Veteran's Haven (1 bedroom apartments)
- Safe Step (2 and 3 bedroom houses and duplex)
